



## 2025 Fall Vegas Baby Survey Results

**Golf Results:** During last years survey, we heard your feedback that you wanted more variety. So we reintroduced two courses making sure we added a seldomly used course back into the rotation.

The overall rankings were tough as we had a lot of wet weather leading up to the event and of course the washout mid round Tuesday. Playing on Sunday or Wednesday after the heavy rains would have been a bit unfair to grade the course conditions.

**Southshore and Revere's Lexington** were used again after a 15-year break. With the exception of breakfast at SS, they delivered. Lexington is not the type of course that will ever crack the top 3, but we heard many positive comments about it being a fun track and one that people would be open to play again every few years.

**Spanish Trail** is a newer one of our rotations and the main comments we heard were simply the disappointment of not getting to play all 18 that day due to the weather. It was nice to see that with the curve ball of rain, the respondents felt the staff were helpful.

Our staples **Dragon Ridge** and **Reflection Bay** left our players happy with DR being one of the favourites and it won for the best conditioned and service. RB was in the best condition that I had seen in many years.

**Paiute** was unfortunately played over the weekend which had one day of all day rain and the next day it was recovering from that rain. The greens were arguably the best before the rains started.

**Serket** ranked lower than in the past. Serket (old Rio Secco) had Sunday after the Saturday rain and the rainout halfway through on the Tuesday. So their rankings were understandably lower. In general, its condition was inconsistent with some well-groomed fairways while others didn't take the overseed well.

I believe the biggest challenge that **Cascata** faced with rating their facility was that we have played them for 20 of the 25 years they have been open. We have a high expectations for the conditioning of the course. Personally, I found Cascata much better than last year, but still not like the old days of 13 stamp greens where you were scared to be above the pin. So their ranking might have something to do with our expectations vs actual poor conditioning.

Breakfast at Cascata and Serket both tied for the best, but we did see your comments looking for a bit of variety and possibly some healthy options.

**Hotel Rankings:** Paris Hotel seemed to have two polarizing responses which leads me to believe that they are in a transition of room renovations. Most surveys mentioned of room quality being high and then others that ranked it 2-3. It is arguably the best location on the center of the strip.

Gaming experience is a tough one too. I ventured out to the other casinos and found similar higher table limits than normal. I think this had to a lot to do with F1 coming right after our event.

Like most of you, I was pleasantly surprised that getting in and out of Horseshoe made it better than anticipated and many times better than last year when we were at Caesars post F1.
